

Scoring a match

This is easy to do. Just pay attention to the referee! Double check that you have the correct wrestlers on the mat and that both you and the ref know which one is labeled “red” and which one is “green”. Have the entire table crew talk out loud about what is happening in the match. If ref holds up “two takedown green,” you should all say it out loud in order to help each other.

Take down 2:	T2
Escape 1:	E1
Reversal 2:	R2
Near Fall 2:	N2
Near Fall 3:	N3
Possibly Near Fall 4:	N4

Add up the points scored in the match and bring the total to the far right side of the page.

If there is a “PIN”, record the amount of time it took for the pin and DO NOT add up the points scored in the match.

CIRCLE THE WINNER’S NAME AND PUT A SMALL ‘X’ THROUGH THE LOSER’S NAME

Time Limits for Matches

PeeWee	3 rounds	1 minute each
Bantam	3 rounds	1 minute each
Intermediates	3 rounds	1 minute each
Novice	3 rounds	1 minute each
Schoolboy/girl	3 rounds	90 seconds each
Cadet	3 rounds	90 seconds each
Junior	3 rounds	2 minutes each

Color Coding:

PeeWee=Goldenrod

Bantam=Pink

Intermediates=Blue

Novice=White

Schoolboy/girl=Green

Cadet=Yellow

Junior=Purple
